## **Handwashing in Uganda**

The Medical Checks for Children Foundation (MCC) provides medical information in countries where children still have to do without a child health clinic or school doctor. They reach about 10,000 children every year. A board member of the foundation asked for help in the development of child-friendly information material. The third flyer has now been scheduled. After 'Brushing Teeth', 'Washing Hands' we are now working on material about the importance of 'Healthy Food'. We regularly receive beautiful photos from Uganda, Nepal or South Africa.

## **Aisha in Special Care Schools**

Sometimes you have those partners with whom working together comes 'naturally'. In the contacts with KidsCare Kenya, one activity follows from the other. Teachers of Special School Units (for children with disabilities) were trained as planned over the last months. In 2024 the trainings for parents and social workers in the villages have been scheduled already. A great target group to work for!



### Child abuse a big problem!

The Corona period, for example, has increased the number of teenage pregnancies in many countries, where girls did not have the usual protection of the school for a while. We have received requests to produce educational material about children's rights many times. A culturally complicated and sensitive subject in our perception. We decided to join only programs that are put together in a professional way. Last year we spoke with FTKilimanjaro, a foundation from Moshi (Tz). Their community-based approach appeals. Currently we are establishing the right conditions to start the project whilst already working together on the topic in a careful manner. Sometime in mid-2024, we expect the first materials on 'Child Protection'.

### **Kilifi County Referral Hospital**

A number of doctors, nurses and social workers want to make their hospital more child-friendly. They involved Aisha & Friends in their project and together we designed a beautiful 'Me in Hospital' book. A real activity book that helps to process all impressions during a hospital stay. We worked together on this theme in workshops. In 2024 we will implement a more extensive training for the Children's ward staff. To be continued!

Teachers from previous Speak Up! Training courses took us into their practice. Emotions are discussed during sports and games at school, during dance and music and during the... First aid lesson. In addition to the practical skills, the lesson we attended also focused on a number of drastic emergencies from the past in which the children were involved. Under the professional guidance of a teacher, they spoke. Emotions were given a place!




# Speak Up!-training enters new phase
